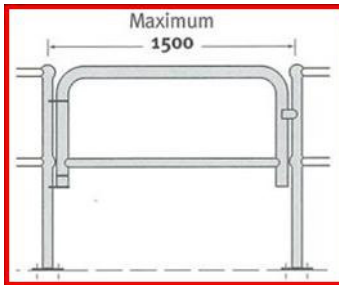
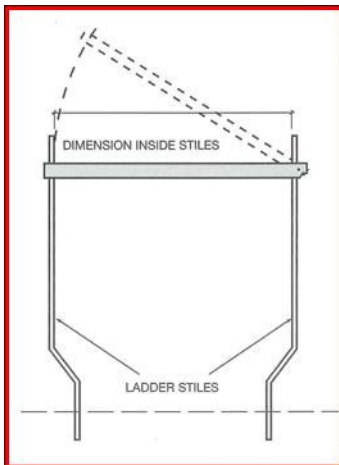


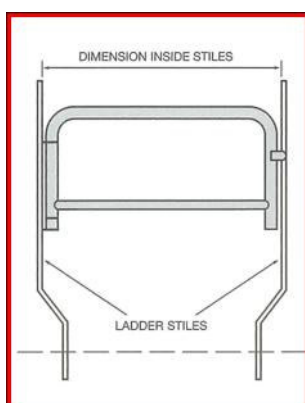
This illustration shows a self-closing gate with a kick plate. The gate has a standard 25NB top railing and 25NB bottom railing.



This illustration shows a self-closing gate with no kick plate. The gate has a standard 25NB at the top railing and 25NB bottom railing. It is important to note the maximum width of 1500mm – a requirement for a greater width will be resolved by double gates.



This illustration shows a self-closing offset drop barrier mounted on ladder stiles. This design is used at the top of ladders to ensure compliance with OH&S requirements.

## SWING DIRECTION

Please note that it is very important to specify the swing direction when ordering your self-closing gate. It should always be TOWARDS a platform and should never open over a space.

Options are South East Swing (SE) or South West Swing (SW).
